




As scientists this term...


We will be looking at the life cycles of Mammals, Birds, Amphibians and Insects.


We will describe the process of reproduction in some plants and animals.

We will be looking at dance, choreographing routines using unison and cannon techniques.




We will be playing hockey developing our dribbling and passing skills.
