Around the World





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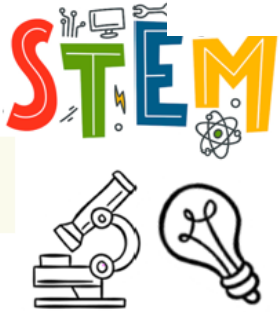


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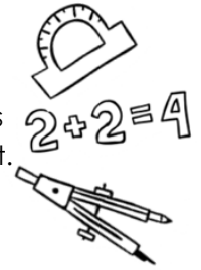


As scientists and engineers this term...

We will identify and compare the suitability of different materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard. We will explore how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

As mathematicians this term...

We will use multiplication, division, fractions and measurement to solve mathematical problems. We will develop our reasoning skills to support our explanation of our working out.



In P.E. this term...

We will develop confidence in swimming skills and master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination.



As geographers, we will...

Identify the Equator on a map and understand its relationship to different climates. We will compare the human and physical features of London to Kingston and the difference in climate between the countries England/UK and Jamaica. Throughout the term we will name and locate the different continents and oceans in the world.



As writers this term...

We will use two key texts ('The Snail and The Whale' and 'Meerkat Mail') to develop our narrative writing skills which will include subordinated and co-ordinated sentences with a variety of punctuation, and become more consistent with the use of past tense.



For our well being...

We will develop an understanding of safety on roads, medicines and online. We will identify differences between secrets and surprises, and learn the meaning of privacy.



As artists this term...

We will explore Jamaican prints and draw our own design. Through printing with paint, using objects and blocks in a repeated pattern, we will create our own artwork.
